ORDER No. 55 of the Rector of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń

of 6 April 2020

Rules of the call for mobility for students of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń

Pursuant to art. 52.3 of the NCU Statutes in Toruń of 16 April 2019 (Biuletyn Prawny UMK of 2019, item 120)

i t i s o r d e r e d as follows:

Article 1

The call for mobility for students of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń, hereinafter referred to as the "call", is organised under the "Excellence Initiative - Research University" programme (*pl. IDUB*) in which the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń (hereinafter referred to as the University) was awarded the status of a Research University by the decision of the Minister of Science and Higher Education.

Article 2

1. The objective of the call is to enable students of the University to gain international educational experience through the implementation of visits to universities abroad with which the University has signed a partnership agreement under the YUFE programme or under inter-university partnerships implemented by Centres of Excellence in Research and Emerging Fields.
2. The list of partner universities of the University is attached as Annex 1 to these Rules.
3. Two editions of the call are planned every year until 2025 until the funds earmarked for this purpose under the IDUB programme have been exhausted.
4. Financial support under the call for a one-semester visit to a scientific institution abroad may be obtained in the form of an increase in the Erasmus+ mobility grant.
5. A student may submit one application in one edition of the call.
6. The increase in the scholarship referred to in art. 2.4 shall be as follows:
 - 1) PLN 2 000 per month for mobility to Group 1 countries, i.e. Denmark, Finland, Ireland, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Norway, Sweden, the United Kingdom,
 - 2) PLN 1 800 per month for mobility to countries from Group 2, i.e. Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, France, Greece, Spain, the Netherlands, Malta, Germany, Portugal and Italy,
 - 3) PLN 1 600 per month for mobility to Group 3 countries, i.e. Bulgaria, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Estonia, Northern Macedonia (FYROM), Lithuania, Latvia, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Turkey, Hungary.
7. Income tax shall be deducted from the amount of the scholarship increase.

Article 3

1. Applications to the call should be sent to mobilnosci@umk.pl with the annotation "Konkurs – Mobilność studentów".
2. The complete application should include:
 - 1) cover letter,
 - 2) CV with a list of achievements covering the student's scientific activity,
 - 3) certificate of the average of all grades obtained in the previous academic year.
3. Where the student has received funding under this call, they shall submit within two months from the date of announcement of the results of the call a confirmation of receiving an Erasmus+ grant to the chair of the IDUB Working Group 3.
4. Submissions under the call shall be evaluated by the call committees composed of experts representing Councils for Fields of Science in three field groups: Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences, Physical Sciences and Engineering, and Life Sciences.
5. Applications that do not meet formal requirements shall not be subject to substantive assessment. The Applicant may be requested to complete the application within the time limit set by the call committee.
6. The substantive assessment of application for mobility shall take into account:
 - 1) scientific activity of the student (from 0 to 50 points);
 - 2) average grades: the number of points is the product of the average and the number 10 (up to 50 points).The application assessment report is attached as annex no. 2 to these Rules
7. Call committees shall make lists of laureates in three field groups based on the results of the substantive assessment.
8. The lists of call laureates shall be announced at www.umk.pl/idub and each applicant shall be informed of the decision sent by e-mail to the address provided in the application form and shall receive an assessment report for their application.
9. The mobility must be implemented within 12 months of the announcement of the decision of the call committee.

Article 4

1. The decision of the call committee may be appealed against in writing within 7 days from the date of the announcement of the results to mobilnosci@umk.pl. The decision of the call committee upon appeal shall be final.
2. The organiser has the right to amend the provisions of these Rules. The Organiser shall each time inform about any amendment to these Rules by publishing its new version on www.umk.pl/idub.
3. Queries regarding the call may be sent to mobilnosci@umk.pl.
