



# MOBILITY FOR EMPLOYEES

## SHORT-TERM VISITS

The objective of the call is to enable experienced researchers employed at the University to gain international research experience through short-term visits to recognised foreign scientific institutions, that lasts for 2-4 weeks.

### Who can take part in the call?

- The call is open to any person employed at the University as a **professor** or a **university professor**.
- The call is also open to persons who are employed at the University as **assistant professors** or **assistants** provided they were awarded the doctoral degree more than three years prior to the submission of the application.

A submission in English must include the following information:

- curriculum vitae in which the applicant describes their scientific activities, internships, scientific scholarships, etc.,
- list of scientific projects which have been completed or are being implemented,
- list of 10 most important publications published in the last 5 years,
- confirmation of the invitation (scan) from the entity which shall host the Applicant,
- proposal - description of activities that the Applicant plans to undertake during their visit.

Applications shall be evaluated with regard to their formal and substantive aspects by call committees composed of experts from Scientific Councils for Fields of Science (RNDN) in three field groups:

- Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences,
- Exact Sciences, Natural Sciences and Engineering,
- Life Sciences.

The visit must be completed within 12 months of the receipt of the funds for its implementation.

Documents that shall be submitted after the visit:

- the report on the implementation of the visit,
- the assessment of the implementation of the visit provided by the entity hosting the Applicant.
