- 3) justification for applying for the internship with an indication of the benefits to the student's course of study,
- 4) a recommendation, e.g. from the dean, supervisor, scientific circle supervisor, year supervisor, class instructor, etc., including, for example, an assessment of the impact of the internship on the realization of the learning outcomes assumed for the subjects indicated by the dean,
- 5) for people with disabilities - a copy of the disability certificate.
