  - 1) **InCites** – JIF Quartile, Journal Impact Factor, 5-Year Impact Factor, Article Influence, Impact Factor excluding Self-Citations, JCI Percentile, JCI Quartile, Citation Impact, All Open Access Documents, % of Documents Cited, Gold Open Access Documents, Gold-Hybrid Documents,
  - 2) **Scopus** - CiteScore, SJR (SCImago Journal Rank), SNIP (Source Normalized Impact per Paper),
  - 3) **SciVal** - Citation Count, Citations per Publication, Publications in Top 10% Journal Percentiles by CiteScore Percentile (%), Outputs in Top 10% Citation Percentiles (%), Outputs in Top 10% Views Percentiles (%), Cited Publications (%), Field-Weighted Citation Impact.
2. The Committee's analysis also takes into account whether the journal is listed in available databases of journals recognized as predatory.
